

Bursary for Voluntarism at Fairhaven

Available to recent graduates and students who are now in their final year of high school in the 2018/2019 school year, who are enrolled in a Kawartha Pine Ridge District School Board or Peterborough Victoria Northumberland & Clarington Catholic School Board and who have made lasting and meaningful contributions to the volunteer activities at Fairhaven. Bursaries of \$250 (maximum of two) will be awarded to each of the successful applicants.

Students, who are considered eligible shall be pursuing post-high school studies at a recognized post-secondary educational program, have good character, and community service involvement. The final decision as to the awarding of the bursaries shall be that of the selection committee made up of individuals from the administration and employees of Fairhaven and the Resident and Family Councils.

Important

A complete application consists of the following elements:

- This application form, fully completed and signed;
- A letter of recommendation from your school, written by a senior official, such as your principal, guidance counsellor, or teacher;
- A transcript of your academic record;
- A one (1) page essay on the “Importance of Voluntarism”;
- Proof of acceptance at a post-secondary educational institution for the academic year commencing September 2019; **(if pending please note)**
- Two references, including contact information and phone numbers.

- No other material will be considered by the Bursary Committee.
- Retain copies of application materials, as originals cannot be returned.
- The successful applicant(s) will be notified in writing by the end of June 2018

Deadline

All applications and documents must be postmarked no later than May 31st, 2019

Before Distribution of Bursary Money, successful applicants must provide confirmation of registration at a post-secondary institution.
